❑ **Original Final Project Body of Work**

Presentation must consist of completed scope of work approved at Midpoint Review. The rigor of the Final Project must be demonstrated.

❑ **Original Directed Study Journal** (18 units)

The Directed Study Journal will be reviewed by the Committee, and will be returned to you at the end of the Review. Please include sketches, studies, and reference images. The journals should record each meeting in directed study, and should support the evolution of ideas generated in each directed study.

❑ **Portfolio:** Copy of portfolio or slides, which you intend to show to prospective employers/galleries.

❑ **Final Project Presentation**

a. **Written: Final Project Synopsis** must be turned in 2 weeks prior to your Review date. Please submit 6 copies, **bound** and of professional quality to the Final Review Coordinator, room 270A, 79 New Montgomery Street. Cover page must specify the following:

- Title of Project
- Student's Name and ID
- Date of Final Review
- Content must be substantial
- Exploration must be evident

b. **Oral:** Come prepared to give a professional oral presentation. It should consist of an overview of your work and be no more than 20 minutes in duration. Be prepared to defend the conceptual solution of the Final Project. Do not read. Index cards are acceptable.

SUPPORTING DETAILS

- Meet with Department Director before Final Review
- Samples of previous Final Projects available from Department Director
- Reserve Final Review location

❑ **Final Project for Library**

a. **Format:** The Department requires you to submit 2 copies of project visuals (1 CD, and 1 set of slides or prints) documenting your final project to be archived in the AAC library.

b. **Archival Box:** It must be paper, not plastic. Your Final Project Visuals must fit inside. It may be purchased at Patrick's Office supply, on Mission at 2nd Street. It should be 9"x12" and cost generally runs \$13.00. Please bring visuals and archive box on the day of your Review.

All materials submitted must be clearly labeled with your name, student ID number, date of Final Review, Major and project title. If your materials are incomplete, the granting of your degree will be delayed.
