

Final Review Requirements

- ❑ **Original Final Project Body of Work:** Presentation must consist of completed scope of work approved at Midpoint Review.

Depending on emphasis (Design, Knitwear or Textiles) work presented should be in the form of swatches, illustrations, 3D garments, etc.

- ❑ **Original Directed Study Journal** (18 units): The required Directed Study Journal will be reviewed by the Committee, and will be returned to you at the end of the review. Please include sketches, color swatches and storyboard if applicable.

- ❑ **Portfolio:** Please bring your portfolio that you intend to show to prospective employers.

- ❑ **Final Project Presentation:**

- a. **Written: Final Project Synopsis** must be turned in 2 weeks prior to your Review date. Please submit 6 copies, **bound** and of professional quality to the Final Review Coordinator, room 270A, 79 New Montgomery Street. Cover page must specify the following:

- Title of Project
- Student's Name, ID and Major
- Date of Final Review

- b. **Oral:** Come prepared to give a professional oral presentation. It should consist of an overview of your work and be no more than 20 minutes in duration.

- a. **Final Project Synopsis Paper:**

- CONCEPT

- Please discuss the market segment for which you have designed the senior collection.

- SCALE

- Want to know what you have produced
 - If Design – display at least 8 outfits & a portfolio expected
 - If Textiles – display a portfolio of at least 8 projects

- ❑ **Final Project for Library**

- a. **Format:** The Department requires you to submit 2 copies of visuals (CD, slides etc.) documenting your Final Project and any prints to be archived in the AAC library. Bring to the Final Review.

- b. **Archival Box:** It must be paper, not plastic. Your Final Project Visuals must fit inside. It may be purchased at Patrick's Office supply, on Mission at 2nd Street. It should be 9"x12" and cost generally runs \$13.00. Bring to the Final Review.

All materials submitted must be clearly labeled with your name, student ID number, date of Final Review and Major. If your materials are incomplete, the granting of your degree will be delayed.
